

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Natural Resources, Fish, and Wildlife to which was  
3 referred Senate Bill No. 287 entitled “An act relating to aquatic nuisance  
4 control” recommends that the House propose to the Senate that the bill be  
5 amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu  
6 thereof the following:

7 \* \* \* Aquatic Nuisance and Rapid Response Control Activities \* \* \*

8 Sec. 1. REPORT ON IMPLEMENATTION OF THE GENERAL PERMIT  
9 FOR NONCHEMICAL AQUATIC NUISANCE AND RAPID  
10 RESPONSE CONTROL ACTIVITES

11 On or before January 15, 2019, the Secretary of Natural Resources shall  
12 submit to the House Committee on Natural Resources, Fish, and Wildlife and  
13 the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Energy a report regarding the  
14 implementation in 2018 of the general permit for the use of nonchemical  
15 aquatic nuisance and rapid response control activities issued under 10 V.S.A.  
16 § 1455(m) and 2017 Acts and Resolves No. 67, Sec. 9. The report shall  
17 include a summary of the implementation of the general permit, the process for  
18 approval of notices of intent for coverage under the general permit, the number  
19 of persons who applied for coverage under the general permit, the number of  
20 persons who were approved for coverage under the general permit, and any  
21 recommendations to improve the implementation of the general permit.



1           (F) the management of “development soils,” as that term is defined in  
2           subdivision 6602(39) of this title, under a plan approved by the Secretary of  
3           Natural Resources under section 6604c of this title.

4           (2) Any development subsequent to the construction of improvements  
5           for any one of the actions or abatements authorized in subdivision (1) of this

8           Sec. 3. 10 V.S.A. § 1523(b) is amended to read:

9           (b) A retailer, with the prior approval of the secretary, may refuse to redeem  
10           beverage containers if a redemption center or centers or other retailers who  
11           redeem beverage containers are established ~~which~~ in the municipality and  
12           serve the public need.

14           Sec. 4. Effective Dates

15           (a) This section and Sec. 2 (Act 250 corrective action plans) shall take  
16           effect on passage.

17           (b) All other sections shall take effect on July 1, 2018.

18           and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: “An act  
19           relating to aquatic nuisance control, Act 250 corrective actions, and beverage  
20           container redemption”
