Representative Brennan of Colchester moves that the House propose to the Senate that the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 2, 10 V.S.A. § 1454, by striking out subsection (c) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(c) Presumption of compliance; Aquatic nuisance species inspection station. A person transporting a vessel to or from a water will be presumed to have not violated subsections (a), (b), and (d) of this section if, upon launching a vessel and upon leaving a water, the vessel is decontaminated at an approved aquatic nuisance inspection station. If staff of an approved aquatic nuisance inspection station observe a violation of subsection (a), (b), or (d) of this section, staff shall notify the person transporting the vessel. If the person transporting the vessel does not correct the violation before launching the vessel or transporting away from the water, the staff of the approved aquatic nuisance inspection station may report the violation to an appropriate law enforcement entity.

Second: In Sec. 4, 10 V.S.A. § 1461, in subsection (c), by striking out the last sentence in the subsection in its entirety
