

Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation

Stormwater Operating Permits -- 10 V.S.A. 1264(c)(1) & (5), 1264(e)

- Applies to new construction or redevelopment of one acre or more of impervious surface; expansions of 5,000 square feet that result in one acre or more of impervious surface; and residual designations made by Secretary
- Approximately 2,265 permit holders pay annual stormwater operating fees
- Total FY18 projected fee revenues from 1264(c)(1) stormwater operating permits = \$1,014,100
- Annual operating fees are authorized by 3 V.S.A. §2822(j)(2)(B)(iv)(I), (II) & (V)
- Fee revenues support DEC staff costs
- DEC sends invoices. Limited ability to pay online.

 - MRGP – municipal road general permit
