RE: Vermont State Library Grant with Vermont Law School: January Report

Dear Ms. Reid,

This correspondence provides a mid-year summary of expenditures and activities for the 2016-2017 Grant Agreement #11300-17-VLS-01 from the Vermont Department of Libraries to the Vermont Law School. At the midpoint of our second year, we continue to welcome more on-site visitors. We have "regulars" as well as researchers new to our services. The recent Westlaw statistics nearly doubled and confirms our observation that our "regulars" are very comfortable using Westlaw. As you will see from the attached Gimlet report covering July 1 – January 31<sup>st</sup>, we logged 253 reference requests. My reference colleagues and I worked with attorneys, self-represented litigants, inmates and other members of the public to provide legal information.

During the period July 1, 2016 – January 31, 2017, the Vermont Law School library documented the following work in satisfaction of the grant:

- Answered 253 reference and directional questions from the public
  - o 45 via the Ask a Law Librarian Line
  - o 33 via direct Email
  - o 90 via walk in patron
  - o 85 inmate requests for legal materials
- Identified 90 visitors. We do not ask visitors to check in, so the actual number of visitors is likely higher.
- Logged 2,740 transactions, on Westlaw public access legal research terminals (July 1, 2016 – January 31, 2017)
- Community Legal Research Corner (CLIC) Coordinator Salary and Benefits June 25, 2016 - January 20, 2017: \$15,758.15.

In addition to the Gimlet report, attached please also find a spreadsheet itemizing expenditures. After receiving the grant funds in December 2016, we plan to move ahead with increasing online access to either public access LexisAdvance or Bloomberg Law. The content gap that we continue to see is with specialized secondary content. For example, we receive repeated requests for Larson's multi-volume treatise, *The Law of Workers' Compensation*. We do not own this title in print (our academic subscription to LexisAdvance provides access the VLS students, faculty and staff.) Ordering the print title for CLIC would cost \$7,775. Our best solution is to obtain public access to either LexisAdvance or Bloomberg Law, either of which would provide access to secondary and practice related resources on employment law and workers' compensation.

Please let me know if you have any questions about any of the expenses listed.

Please let me know what additional information I can provide. On behalf of my VLS library colleagues and all the legal researchers who benefit from CLIC, let me take this opportunity to formally thank you for your support of this program. We could not have done it without you. We look forward to continuing to serve the State of Vermont moving forward, and we wish you all the best in the months ahead.


