Subject: Developmental services

Hello,

I am writing against the proposed \$4.3 million budget cut in developmental services.

My name is David Woodberry, from East Dummerston. My sister has a 38 year old son has a developmental disability. He is supported by the Specialized Service Agency, Families First. I have known him all his life. School years were very rough as he didn't seem to fit in anywhere. As an adult he has a full productive life because of the individualized programming and support of Families First. Nathan has been employed for 17 years. He is involved in community activities. His life without support services would be lonely and unproductive. Because of previous budget cuts (\$14.1 million over the past 9 years) he has not had staff or had to double up on staff and was unable to work. The governor's proposed budget has a \$4.3 million reduction in the budget for Developmental Services. This would have a devastating effect on Nathan and Family's First. Why in Vermont are we destroying a program which has been successfully supporting our most vulnerable population?

Developmental services in Vermont are already known for being cost effective. Do not cut any more funding out of the developmental services budget.
