9	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require an
10	automobile dealer to remove an Internet advertisement for a vehicle within
11	48 hours from the time it is sold and to require an automobile dealer to disclose
12	clearly in an advertisement whether a vehicle is for sale or for lease, or both,
13	and on what terms.

15	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

17	§ 2466c. AUTOMOBILE ADVERTISING
18	(a) In any advertisement for an automobile that is available for sale or lease
19	to consumers, an automobile dealer shall specify in clear and conspicuous
20	language:

1	(1) whether the vehicle is available for sale or for lease, or both; and
2	(2) the price and terms that relate to the sale or the lease of the vehicle.
3	(b) An automobile dealer who advertises an automobile for sale or lease to
4	consumers on the Internet shall remove the automobile advertisement from the
5	Internet within 48 hours of the time it becomes unavailable for sale or lease.
