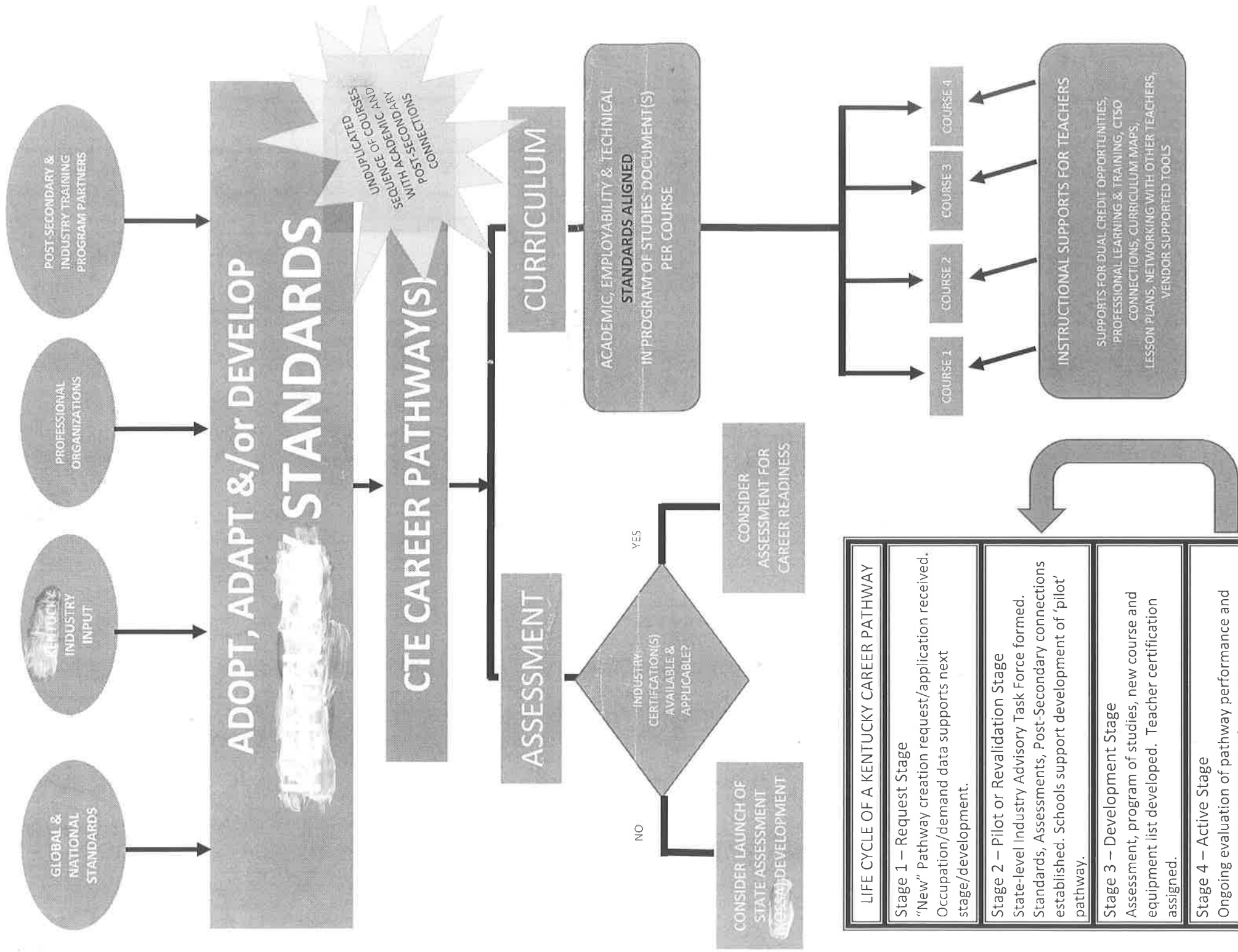


# STANDARDS, CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENT



LIFE CYCLE OF A KENTUCKY CAREER PATHWAY
<p><b>Stage 1 – Request Stage</b>                      “New” Pathway creation request/application received. Occupation/demand data supports next stage/development.</p>
<p><b>Stage 2 – Pilot or Revalidation Stage</b>                      State-level Industry Advisory Task Force formed. Standards, Assessments, Post-Secondary connections established. Schools support development of ‘pilot’ pathway.</p>
<p><b>Stage 3 – Development Stage</b>                      Assessment, program of studies, new course and equipment list developed. Teacher certification assigned.</p>
<p><b>Stage 4 – Active Stage</b>                      Ongoing evaluation of pathway performance and continuous improvement of supports.</p>
<p><b>Stage 5 – Phase Out Stage</b>                      Pathway targeted for phase out due to duplication of effort of ineffective performance. Timeline established to communicate phase out.</p>
<p><b>Stage 6 – Inactive/Terminated Stage</b>                      Pathway no longer active. Electronic retention of foundational elements of pathway.</p>
