1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Commerce and Economic Development to which was
3	referred House Bill No. 854 entitled "An act relating to promoting television
4	and film production" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5	recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting
6	clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES;
8	TELEVISION AND FILM PRODUCTION
9	The Department of Labor, in partnership with the Agency of Commerce and
10	Community Development and the Career Pathways Coordinator within the
11	Agency of Education, shall have the authority to explore means to expand and
12	encourage apprenticeship, CTE, Career Pathways, and continuing education
13	opportunities in television and film production. The Department and its
14	partners shall have the further authority to conduct outreach to middle school,
15	high school, and postsecondary students to gauge interest and need for
16	opportunities in this field.
17	Sec. 2. TELEVISION AND FILM PRODUCTION; RECRUITMENT
18	STRATEGY; IMPACT STATEMENT
19	On or before January 15, 2019, the Agency of Commerce and Community
20	Development shall consider and report to the House Committee on Commerce
21	and Economic Development and the Senate Committee on Economic

1	Development, Housing and General Affairs on a recommended strategy for
2	attracting television and film production activities to Vermont and include an
3	economic impact statement specifying potential revenues from increased
4	activities.
5	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
6	This act shall take effect on passage.
