15	(34) "Independent truck owner-operator" means a person that operates a
16	truck or tractor-trailer for the purpose of transporting goods or materials to or
17	from a commercial construction site who:
18	(A) operates a separate and distinct business from the persons
19	performing construction services at the commercial construction site;
20	(B) holds itself out as in business for itself and offers its services to
21	the general public;

1	(C) owns or leases the truck or tractor-trailer; and
2	(D) is responsible for the maintenance and operating costs of the
3	truck or tractor-trailer, including fuel, repairs, insurance, and related costs.

7	§ 617. COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION; MANDATORY PROVISION
8	OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
9	(a) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, all
10	individuals performing construction services on a commercial construction
11	site, except for an independent truck owner-operator, shall be covered by
12	workers' compensation insurance pursuant to section 687 of this chapter.
13	(b) Notwithstanding section 612 of this chapter, a corporate executive
14	officer or L.L.C. manager or member that is performing construction services
15	on a commercial construction site shall have workers' compensation coverage
16	pursuant to the requirements of this chapter during the time that he or she is
17	performing the construction services.
