

SKILL LAB: The purpose of the 45-minute skill labs is to provide targeted instruction around a specific skill. Students will be grouped homogeneously based on readiness (as determined by the most recent formative assessment data) and provided with appropriately supportive and/or challenging instruction and practice. Skill labs meet every red day (Monday, Thursday).

DISCIPLINE-SPECIFIC CLASS: The purpose of the 45-minute classes is to provide focused skill instruction using discipline-specific content. Content will be related to the problems that students are solving during project time. Each course meets twice a week for 45 minutes.
