Extraordinary Special Education Reimbursement

Examples

Example 1

- Assume
 - o SU has special education expenditures of \$80,000 for one student
 - Threshold amount is \$70,000 (4.62 X \$15,151 (statewide average district education spending per equalized pupil))
 - o Base amount of educational support grant is \$1,800
- Reimbursement would be:
 - \circ 90% X \$10,000 (amount that exceeds threshold) = **\$9,000** +
 - o <u>Lesser</u> of:
 - \$10,000 (amount that exceeds threshold) or
 - 60% X \$68,200 (\$70,000 (threshold amount) \$1,800 (base amount)) = \$40,920
- Therefore, would receive \$19,000 (\$9,000 + \$10,000). Under draft 6.1, would have received \$49,920 (\$9,000 + \$40,920).

Example 2

- Assume
 - o SU has special education expenditures of \$115,000 for one student
 - o Threshold amount is \$70,000 (4.62 X \$15,151 (statewide average district education spending per equalized pupil))
 - o Base amount of educational support grant is \$1,800
- Reimbursement would be:
 - \circ 90% X \$45,000 (amount that exceeds threshold) = **\$40,500** +
 - o Lesser of:
 - \$45,000 (amount that exceeds threshold), or
 - 60% X \$68,200 (\$70,000 (threshold amount) \$1,800 (base amount)) = **\$40,920**
- Therefore, would receive \$81,420 (\$40,500 + \$40,920). Under draft 6.1, would have received the same.
