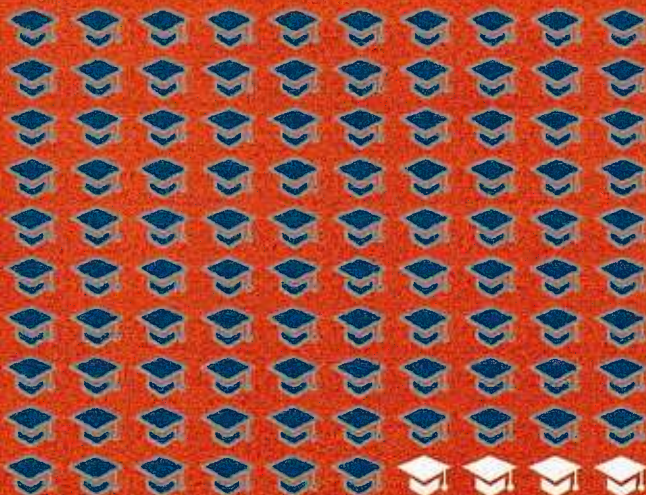

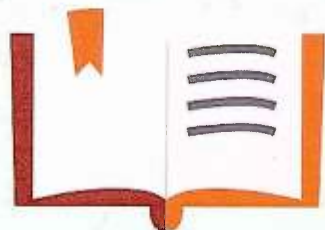
During the 2014/2015 school year, 96% of students who participated in Career & Technical Education in VT went on to graduate from high school. These rates are above the impressive national average of 93%.

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## THE CTE ADVANTAGE



### Rigorous Curriculum

Career & Technical Centers provide students with a rigorous curriculum that seamlessly blends instructional time with hands on learning. Core academic subjects such as math, science, and reading are integrated with CTE instruction. This is a proven method for improving students' academic performance.



### Work-based Learning

Work-based Learning is a strategy that allows students to apply academic and technical skills and develop employability skills. Work-based Learning includes Job Shadows, Career Work Experiences (during class time) and Cooperative Technical Education placements.



### College Credits
