Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to direct the
Attorney General, in consultation with the Commissioner of Public Service, to
adopt privacy and data security rules applicable to telecommunications service
providers subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Service Board under
30 V.S.A. § 203(5), including broadband Internet access service providers.
The rules shall be modeled after the Federal Communications Commission's
2016 Privacy Order, 47 C.F.R. part 64, subpart U.
