

Summary of Senate Appropriations Amendment to H.238

First Instance of Amendment. 7 V.S.A. § 113. Administration; Apportionment of costs

- Provides that the administrative costs of the Department of Liquor and Lottery that are not specific to either the Division of Liquor Control or the Division of Lottery shall be allocated to the Liquor Control Fund and Lottery Fund based on Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

Second Instance of Amendment. Apportionment of costs; report

- Requires the Commissioner of Liquor and Lottery to report on the allocation of costs pursuant to 7 V.S.A. § 113.

Third Instance of Amendment. 7 V.S.A. § 5. Raffles for right to purchase rare spirits

- Amends the section to provide that the proceeds from the sale of raffle tickets will be deposited in the Liquor Control Enterprise Fund. This removes the language permitting the Department to designate nonprofit organizations to receive the funds for the purpose of providing programs to prevent underage drinking without legislative oversight.

Fourth Instance of Amendment. Report on proceeds from raffles for right to purchase rare spirits

- Requires Commissioner of Liquor and Lottery to report to the General Assembly by January 15, 2018 regarding the number of products raffled, the number of tickets sold, and the proceeds from the raffles.
