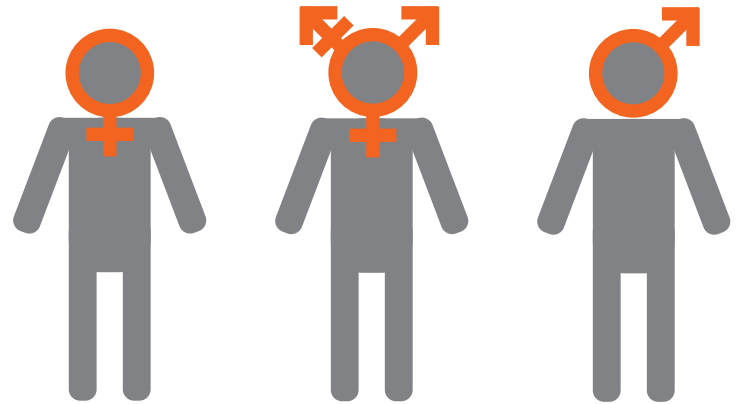


Why do **GENDER-NEUTRAL** bathrooms matter?

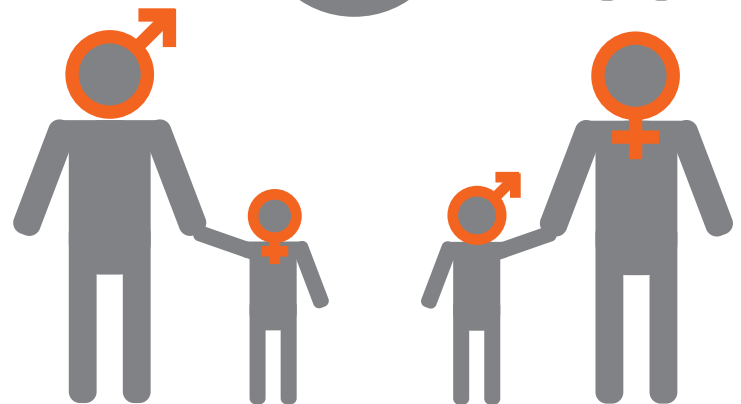
People with Disabilities
