This designation will recognize their bravery and 11 12 educate Vermonters about the sacrifices their fellow citizens have made to 13 protect our nation. The Honor and Remember Flag may be flown on State-14 owned and municipally owned flagpoles, including those at military facilities, 15 war memorials, and veterans cemeteries, on legal holidays and other 16 designated days. The Department of Buildings and General Services may 17 establish a protocol for the flying of the Honor and Remember Flag and may 18 accept donations of the flag to be flown on State-owned flagpoles.
