- 1) Approximately 309,000 (49%) VT'ers get their coverage through ESI (according to 2014 data which is the most recent available)
- 2) We do not know of any specific employers that have 100% coverage of the premium, but I've heard there may be some who do.

Follow up from Nolan:

"Hunger Mountain Coop in Montpelier does cover 100% of the premium for full time employees (not part timers). Only example I know of. They are also a union shop."
