1	TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
2	The Committee on Ways and Means to which was referred House Bill No.
3	899 entitled "An act relating to fees for records filed in town offices and a
4	town fee report and request" respectfully reports that it has considered the
5	same and recommends that the bill be amended by striking out Sec. 1 in its
6	entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 1671 is amended to read:
8	§ 1671. TOWN CLERK <u>FEES RELATED TO RECORDS; RESERVE</u>
9	<u>FUND</u>
10	(a) For the purposes of this section, a "page" is defined as a single side of a
11	leaf of paper on which is printed, written, or otherwise placed information to
12	be recorded or filed. The maximum covered area on a page shall be 7 1/2
13	inches by 14 inches. All letters shall be at least one-sixteenth inch in height or
14	in at least eight point type. Unless otherwise provided by law, the fees to town
15	clerks shall be as follows:
16	(1) For recording a trust mortgage deed as provided in 24 V.S.A.
17	§ 1155, \$10.00 per page; \$25.00 for the first page and \$10.00 for each
18	additional page.
19	(2) For filing or recording a copy of a complaint to foreclose a mortgage
20	as provided in 12 V.S.A. § 4523(b), \$10.00 per page; \$25.00 for the first page
21	and \$10.00 for each additional page.

1	(3) For examination of records by town clerk, a fee of \$5.00 per hour
2	may be charged but not more than \$25.00 for each examination on any one
3	calendar day ; .
4	(4) For examination of records by others, a fee of \$2.00 per hour may be
5	charged;.
6	(5) Town clerks may require fees for all filing, recording, and copying
7	to be paid in advance; [Repealed.]
8	(6)(A) For Except as provided in subdivisions (B) and (C) of this
9	subdivision (6), for the recording or filing, or both, of any document that is to
10	become a matter of public record in the town clerk's office, or for any certified
11	copy of such document, a fee of \$10.00 per page shall be charged; except that
12	for \$25.00 for the first page and \$10.00 for each additional page.
13	(B) For the recording or filing, or both, of a property transfer return, a
14	flat fee of \$10.00 \$25.00 shall be charged;
15	(C) For the recording or filing, or both, of documents issued by a
16	municipal officer, employee, or entity, including land use permits, certificates
17	of compliance or occupancy, and notices of violation, a flat fee of \$20.00 shall
18	be charged.
19	(7) For uncertified copies of records and documents on file, or recorded,
20	a fee of \$1.00 per page shall be charged, with a minimum fee of \$2.00;
21	however, copies of minutes of municipal meetings or meetings of local boards

1	and commissions, copies of grand lists and checklists and copies of any public
2	records that any agency of that political subdivision has deposited with the
3	clerk shall be available to the public at actual cost;.
4	(8) For survey plats filed in accordance with 27 V.S.A. chapter 17, a fee
5	of \$15.00 per 11 inch by 17 inch sheet, \$15.00 per 18 inch by 24 inch sheet,
6	and \$15.00 per 24 inch by 36 inch \$30.00 per sheet shall be charged.
7	(b)(1) A schedule of all fees shall be posted in the town clerk's office.
8	(2) A town clerk may return any record presented for filing or recording
9	if the record is not accompanied by the correct fee.
10	(3) A town clerk may require fees for all filing, recording, and copying
11	to be paid in advance.
12	(c)(1) The legislative body may create shall maintain a Restoration Reserve
13	Fund of no less than \$0.50 per page and no more than \$1.00 per page from
14	recording into which shall be deposited:
15	(A) 10 percent of the fees established collected under subdivisions
16	(a)(1) and, (a)(2), (a)(6), and (a)(8) of this section;
17	(B) any additional fees collected under this section that the legislative
18	body may approve for deposit into the Fund; and
19	(C) any other municipal revenues approved for deposit into the Fund.

1	(2)(A) The Monies in the Restoration Reserve Fund shall be used solely
2	for restoration, preservation, and conservation of municipal records. Permitted
3	uses of Fund monies may include:
4	(i) the purchase of hardware or software related to carrying out
5	these activities in a manner that is consistent with legal requirements; and
6	(ii) the acquisition or maintenance of safes or vaults as required
7	under 24 V.S.A. § 1178.
8	(B) If a municipality has previously established the Fund, no
9	additional action will be required.
10	(d) A legislative body may establish or abolish a Restoration Reserve Fund
11	only by affirmative vote at a legally warned meeting of the legislative body.
12	Nothing in this section shall preclude the legislative body of a municipality
13	from committing funds to a approving for deposit into the Restoration Reserve
14	Fund monies collected under this section that are in addition to those funds in
15	monies reserved to the Fund under subsection (c) of this section.
