- 1.) Sec. 4, 20 V.S.A. § 2352 (Council membership):
 - a. Whether to provide transitional provisions to address the new membership:
 - i. Allow existing members to serve remainder of terms? If so, how to decide who replaces them.
 - Should new members serve different initial term lengths in order to stagger terms? (20 V.S.A. § 2352(a)(2) currently provides that all members serve three-year terms.)
 - b. Whether to permit the public members to receive a per diem. (<u>20 V.S.A.</u> <u>§ 2352(c)</u> currently prohibits members from being compensated.)
- 2.) <u>Sec. 6 (Council; report on training alternatives)</u>: Whether to strike the last sentence that allows this report to be in verbal form, since it will address budgetary implications.
- 3.) Sec. 9 (Law Enforcement State Retirement Benefit Benefits Study Committee): Instead of appropriating the \$75,000 now, whether to revise the duties of the Study Committee so it conducts its Group C Analysis and Retirement Benefit Recommendations in subdivs. (c)(1) and (2), report back on X date, and then determine whether to conduct the actuarial analysis.
