12	abnormalities of the breast or breast tissue. Benefits provided shall cover the
13	full cost of the mammography service and other breast imaging, ultrasound,
14	and magnetic resonance imaging services and shall not be subject to any co-
15	payment, deductible, coinsurance, or other cost-sharing requirement or
16	additional charge, except to the extent that such coverage would disqualify
17	a high-deductible health plan from eligibility for a health savings account
18	pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 223.
19	(b) For females 40 years or older, coverage shall be provided for an annual
20	screening. For females less than 40 years of age, coverage for screening shall
21	be provided upon recommendation of a health care provider. [Repealed.]

1	(c) After January 1, 1994, this This section shall apply only to sereening			
2	procedures conducted by test facilities accredited by the American College of			
3	Radiologists.			
4	(d) As used in this subchapter:			
5	(1) "Insurer" means any insurance company which that provides health			
6	insurance as defined in subdivision 3301(a)(2) of this title, nonprofit hospital			
7	and medical service corporations, and health maintenance organizations. The			
8	term does not apply to coverage for specified disease diseases or other limited			
9	benefit coverage.			
10	(2) "Mammography" means the x-ray examination of the breast using			
11	equipment dedicated specifically for mammography, including the x-ray tube,			
12	filter, compression device, screens, films, and cassettes. The term includes			
13	breast tomosynthesis.			
14	(3) "Other breast imaging services" includes diagnostic			
15	mammography, ultrasound, magnetic resonance imaging, and other			
16	imaging services and technologies that enable health care providers to			
17	detect the presence or absence of breast cancer and other abnormalities			
18	affecting the breast or breast tissue.			
19	"Screening" includes the mammography test procedure and a			
20	qualified physician's interpretation of the results of the procedure, including			
21	additional views and interpretation as needed.
