2 Representative Lippert of Hinesburg moves that the House propose to the
3 Senate that the bill be amended as follows:

4 First: In Sec. 1, in subdivision (3), in the last sentence, by striking out
5 “recovery-oriented” and inserting in lieu thereof “recovery- and resiliency-
6 oriented”

7 Second: In Sec. 1, in subdivision (18), by striking out “recovery-oriented”
8 and inserting in lieu thereof “recovery- and resiliency-oriented”

9 Third: In Sec. 3, in subdivision (a)(1)(A), by striking out “recovery-
10 oriented” and inserting in lieu thereof “recovery- and resiliency-oriented”

11 Fourth: In Sec. 3, in subdivision (a)(1)(C), by striking out the phrase “for
12 emergency services” and inserting in lieu thereof “to emergency departments”

13 Fifth: In Sec. 3, in subdivision (a)(1), by striking out subdivisions (D)–(G)
14 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (D) to read as
15 follows:

16 (D) determine the availability, regional accessibility, and gaps in
17 services that are barriers to efficient, medically necessary, recovery- and
18 resiliency-oriented patient care at levels of support that are least restrictive and
19 most integrated with regard to voluntary and involuntary hospital admissions,
20 emergency departments, intensive residential recovery facilities, secure
21 residential recovery facilities, crisis beds, and other diversion capacities; crisis

1 intervention services; peer respite and support services; intensive and other
2 outpatient services; services for transition age youths; and stable housing;
3 and by relettering the remaining subdivisions to be alphabetically correct.

4 Sixth: In Sec. 3, in subsection (b), by striking out subdivision (1) in its
5 entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new subdivision (1) to read as follows:

6 (b)(1) The Commissioner shall collect data to inform the analysis and
7 action plan described in subsection (a) of this section regarding emergency
8 services for persons with psychiatric symptoms or complaints in the
9 emergency department. The data collected regarding persons presenting in
10 emergency departments with psychiatric symptoms shall include:

11 (A) the circumstances under which and reasons why a person is being
12 referred or self-referred to an emergency department;

13 (B) measurements shown by research to affect length of waits; and

14 (C) rates at which persons brought to emergency departments for
15 emergency examinations pursuant to 18 V.S.A. §§ 7504 and 7505 are found
16 not to be in need of inpatient hospitalization.

17 Seventh: In Sec. 3, in subsection (b), in subdivision (2), following “inform
18 the” by inserting the words “analysis and”, and following the words “action
19 plan” by striking out “and preliminary analysis”

20 Eighth: In Sec. 4, in subdivision (1), in the second to last sentence, by
21 striking out “recovery-oriented” and inserting in lieu thereof “recovery- and

1 resiliency-oriented” and in the last sentence, after the words “during the” by
2 striking out the word “preliminary”

3 Ninth: In Sec. 4, in subdivision (4), in the last sentence, after the words
4 “necessary in the” by striking out the word “preliminary”

5 Tenth: In Sec. 4, in subdivision (6), in the second to last sentence, after the
6 words “If the” by striking out the word “preliminary”

7 Eleventh: In Sec. 4, in subdivision (7), in the last sentence, following the
8 word “The” by inserting “analysis and” and following “action plan” by striking
9 out the words “and preliminary analysis”
