
# Office of Child Support



### Why Child Support?



Almost **40%** of Vermont children born to <u>unwed</u> parents



Nationally, more than ½ of all kids will live in a single parent household at some point



Child Support provides **40%** of family income in poor families where it is received



OCS has 16,864 **cases** around the world



National average cost of raising a child in low income family:

\$200,000

### Studies show that receipt of child support -

- Increases economic independence of parents
- Reduces child poverty
- Reduces reliance on public assistance benefits
- Encourages parents to exit and remain off public assistance
- Increases parental involvement of paying parents

The Office of Child Support works to improve children's economic security by:



Establishing parentage,



Establishing child support and medical obligations, and



Ensuring obligations are met.




