17 § 4474e. DISPENSARIES; CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

19 (d)(1) A dispensary shall implement appropriate security measures to deter  
20 and prevent the unauthorized entrance into areas containing marijuana and the  
21 theft of marijuana and shall ensure that each location has an operational  
22 security alarm system. All cultivation of marijuana shall take place in a secure,

1 locked facility which is either indoors or outdoors, but not visible to the public  
2 and that can only be accessed by the owners, principals, financiers, and  
3 employees of the dispensary who have valid Registry identification cards. An  
4 outdoor facility is not required to have a roof, provided all other requirements  
5 are met. The Department shall perform an annual on-site assessment of each  
6 dispensary and may perform on-site assessments of a dispensary without  
7 limitation for the purpose of determining compliance with this subchapter and  
8 any rules adopted pursuant to this subchapter and may enter a dispensary at  
9 any time for such purpose. During an inspection, the Department may review  
10 the dispensary's confidential records, including its dispensing records, which  
11 shall track transactions according to registered patients' Registry identification  
12 numbers to protect their confidentiality.

14 (4) A dispensary shall submit the results of a financial audit to the  
15 Department of Public Safety ~~no~~ not later than ~~60~~ 90 days after the end of the  
16 dispensary's first fiscal year, and every other year thereafter. The audit shall  
17 be conducted by an independent certified public accountant, and the costs of  
18 any such audit shall be borne by the dispensary. The Department may also  
19 periodically require, within its discretion, the audit of a dispensary's financial  
20 records by the Department.
