



Professor Lynn Kemp

Professor Lynn Kemp is the Director of the Translational Research and Social Innovation team in the School of Nursing and Midwifery at Western Sydney University. Originally trained as a nurse, Professor Kemp has undertaken a significant program of community-based children and young people's research that includes world and Australian-first intervention studies such as the Maternal Early Childhood Sustained Home-visiting (MECSH) study, the Bulundidi Gudaga trial of sustained nurse home visiting in an urban Aboriginal community, the right@home randomized trial of sustained nurse home visiting, and the Volunteer Family Connect trial of volunteer home visiting. Professor Kemp is now leading an international program of translational research, studying the implementation of these effective interventions at population scale world-wide with programs in Australia, England, South Korea and the USA.
