2 Representatives Christie of Hartford, Gonzalez of Winooski, and Morris of  
3 Bennington move that the House concur in the Senate Proposal of Amendment  
4 with further proposal of amendment as follows:

5 First: By striking out Sec. 3 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the  
6 following:

7 Sec. 3. OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; HUMAN RIGHTS  
8 COMMISSION; REPORT

9 The Attorney General, together with the Human Rights Commission and  
10 interested stakeholders, shall develop a strategy to address racial disparities  
11 within the State systems of education, labor and employment, access to  
12 housing and health care, and economic development. The Attorney General  
13 and the Human Rights Commission shall jointly report on the strategy to the  
14 Justice Oversight Committee on or before November 1, 2017.

15 Second: By adding a new Sec. 6a to read as follows:

16 Sec. 6a. REPEAL

17 3 V.S.A. § 168 (Racial Disparities in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice  
18 System Advisory Panel) is repealed on July 1, 2020.
