

OUTCOMES AND INDICATORS

- A) percent of public drinking water supplies in compliance with health-based standards;
- (B) total greenhouse gas emissions per capita, in units of annual metric tons of equivalent carbon dioxide per capita, in units of annual metric tons of equivalent carbon dioxide per capita, including vehicle miles traveled per capita and energy use per capita.
- (C) percent of Vermont's river and lake sections (excluding Lake Champlain) that don't meet state water quality standards for fishing and swimming.
- (D) changes in total phosphorus loading to Lake Champlain from Vermont sources in metric tons per year;
- (E) number of days air quality in Vermont posed a moderate or greater risk to sensitive populations:
- (F) disposal rate of municipal solid waste in pounds per person per day.
- (G) total number of acres that have been converted from forestland to developed land and from farmland to developed land. Also, the percentage of forestland that has been converted to farmland.
