Shadow Lake - Vermont's First Boat Wash

In 2003, the Shadow Lake Association, with support from the town of Glover and VT DEC, established our **hot water + high pressure boat wash station** working to intercept and prevent the transport of aquatic invasive species.

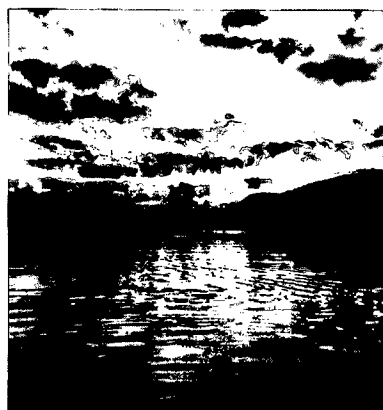


Our Association's ongoing effort supports our mission '*...to preserve the healthy ecology of the lake and to ensure pristine water quality for the benefit of current and future generations.*'

In 2015, of the 27 other locations around the state where watercraft inspections were taking place, Shadow was still the only waterbody location **washing** boats!

Over the years, we have encouraged many lake groups to visit us and learn from our program. Today, a few more VT lakes have also started boat wash stations.

We are proud so many recognize us for '*leading the way*' and refer to the Shadow Lake boat wash as **the "gold standard" for Vermont.**



In 2017, Directors from the Shadow Lake Association provided strong support for VT Act 67 to strengthen aquatic nuisance control.
