# Miscellaneous Taxes on Alcoholic Beverages

#### **6% Sales and Use Tax**

- Sales of alcoholic beverages by retailers, such as grocery stores or convenience stores, that
  - are suitable for human consumption
  - contain one-half of 1% or more of alcohol by volume, and
  - are not provided for immediate consumption.

### 10% Alcoholic Beverage Tax

- 10% Alcoholic Beverage Tax applies to sales of alcoholic beverages provided for immediate consumption, including
  - any malt beverages, vinous beverages, or spirituous liquors, and
  - that are served on the premises of a restaurant or bar by a holder of a firstor third-class liquor license.

### **1% Local Option Tax**

• If alcohol beverages are sold in or delivered to a municipality with a local option tax on alcoholic beverages, those sales are subject to an additional 1% tax (total tax at 7% or 11%).

### **Malt and Vinous Tax**

# Who pays

Bottlers and wholesalers who manufacture or rectify alcohol.
This includes distributors, breweries, and vineyards/wineries.

## Transaction taxed

Tax levied at time of sale to a retailer in Vermont.

# Collection

Tax paid to Commissioner of Taxes




#### **Total Malt and Vinous Revenues**





#### **Malt and Vinous Revenues**


FY 2001 - 2014

FY2015-FY2017






#### **Total Gallons Malt and Vinous Sold**






# Malt and Vinous Gallons Sold
