At the time of the merger of the two business units in 1992, each department had a Director

- Claims − 1

- Total Department 40

The complement of 81 full time employees in both business units remained the same after the merger, with the exception of the Director position, which went from 2 to 1. That was the only reduction in staff after the merger.

I was not able to determine any funding changes from the time before and after the merger. The assumption is that the funding remained the same, since overhead and staffing did not change.

There are only 2 or 3 people who were here in 1992, and have any recollection of the merger, and they were my sources of information for your request. I was not able to find anyone else currently in state government who would be able to remember the situation in 1992.
