2	The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill No. 94		
3	entitled "An act relating to promoting remote work and flexible work		
4	arrangements" respectfully reports that it has considered the same and

6	Housing and General Affairs, as amended by the Committee on Finance, be		
7	further amended by striking out Sec. 1 in its entirety and inserting a new Sec.

9	Sec. 1. NEW REMOTE WORKER GRANT PROGRAM		
10	(a) As used in this section:		
11	(1) "New remote worker" means an individual who:		
12	(A) is a full-time employee of a business with its domicile or primary		
13	place of business outside Vermont;		
14	(B) becomes a full-time resident of this State on or after January 1,		
15	2019; and		
16	(C) performs the majority of his or her employment duties remotely		
17	from a home office or a co-working space located in this State.		
18	(2) "Qualifying remote worker expenses" means a new remote worker's		
19	actual costs incurred for one or more of the following that are necessary to		
20	perform his or her employment duties:		
21	(A) relocation to this State;		

1	(B) computer software and hardware;		
2	(C) broadband access or upgrade; and		
3	(D) membership in a co-working or similar space.		
4	(b)(1) The Agency of Commerce and Community Development shall have		
5	the authority to design and implement the New Remote Worker Grant		
6	Program, which shall include a process to certify new remote workers and		
7	certify qualifying expenses for a grant under this section.		
8	(2) A new remote worker may be eligible for a grant under the Program		
9	for qualifying remote worker expenses in the amount of not more than		
10	\$2,000.00 per year for up to five years, not to exceed \$10,000.00 per new		
11	remote worker.		
12	(3) The Agency may annually award grants under the Program on a		
13	first-come, first-served basis, up to \$250,000.00 in total grants per year, subject		
14	to available funding.		
15	(c) If the Agency implements the Program pursuant to this section, it shall:		
16	(1) promote awareness of the Program; and		
17	(2) adopt measurable goals, performance measures that demonstrate		
18	results, and an audit strategy to assess the utilization and performance of the		
19	Program.
