Hello, my name is Heather Getty and I work for Northwestern Counseling and Support Services with their Parent Child Center; I am currently the team leader of Adolescent Services. At the agency, we use the Strengthening Families Framework, which works with families to identify strengths they already have and to develop new connections and build community.
