15	biennial update proceeding under Rule 5.100 initiated by the Commission in
16	<u>2018.</u>
17	(2) Whether renewable energy plants that qualify as such net metering
18	systems should continue to be encouraged through the Net Metering Program
19	under 30 V.S.A. § 8010 or whether a different program should be employed to
20	encourage such plants. The Commission's consideration of this issue shall
21	include the possible use to encourage such plants of the Standard Offer

1	Program under 30 V.S.A. § 8005a and any other options to encourage such
2	plants identified by the Commission.
3	(3) The Commission's recommendations, if any, for changes to existing
4	statutes applicable to such net metering systems.
5	(4) Any other relevant issues identified by the Commission.
6	(b) Prior to issuing the report required under subsection (a) of this section,
7	the Commission shall convene at least four meetings of affected and interested
8	persons to obtain comment and information on the issues identified in this
9	section. Such persons shall include the Department of Public Service,
10	representatives from the utilities, Renewable Energy Vermont, and developers
11	and customers of net metering systems of 150 kW or greater.
12	(c) Terms used in this section shall have the same meaning as in 30 V.S.A.
