8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to approve the
9	adoption of and codify the charter of the Town of Ferrisburgh.
10 11	An act relating to approval of the adoption and codification of the charter of the Town of Ferrisburgh
12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
13	Sec. 1. CHARTER APPROVAL
14	The General Assembly approves the adoption of and codifies the charter of
15	the Town of Ferrisburgh as set forth in this act. The voters approved the
16	<u>charter on May 11, 2017.</u>

1	Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 119 is added to read:
2	CHAPTER 119. TOWN OF FERRISBURGH
3	§ 1. CORPORATE EXISTENCE RETAINED
4	(a) Pursuant to the authority granted by the General Assembly, there is
5	hereby enacted a charter to govern the organization and operation of local
6	government in the Town of Ferrisburgh.
7	(b) The inhabitants of the Town of Ferrisburgh, within the geographical
8	limits as now established, shall continue to be a municipal corporation by the
9	name of the Town of Ferrisburgh.
10	§ 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS
11	(a) Except when changed, enlarged, or modified by the provisions of this
12	charter, all provisions of the statutes of the State of Vermont relating to
13	municipalities shall apply to the Town of Ferrisburgh.
14	(b) The Town shall have all the powers granted to towns and municipal
15	corporations by the Vermont Constitution and the laws of the State and this
16	charter, together with all implied powers necessary to carry into execution all
17	the powers granted. The Town may enact ordinances not inconsistent with the
18	Constitution of the State or this charter and may impose penalties for violation
19	thereof.

1	(c) In this charter, any mention of particular power shall not be construed to
2	restrict the scope of the powers that the Town would have if the particular
3	power were not mentioned, unless this charter otherwise provides.
4	(d) Nothing in this charter shall be construed in any way to limit powers
5	and functions conferred on the Town, the Selectboard, or its elected or
6	appointed officers by general or special enactment of State statutes or rules in
7	force or effect or hereafter enacted, and the powers and functions conferred by
8	this charter shall be cumulative and in addition to the provisions of the general
9	or special enactment unless this charter otherwise provides.
10	§ 3. APPOINTED OFFICERS
11	(a) In addition to all other offices that may be filled by appointment by the
12	Selectboard pursuant to State law or this charter, the Selectboard shall appoint
13	the following Town officers, who shall serve for such terms as the Selectboard
14	may establish in its act of appointment or until the office otherwise becomes
15	vacant:
16	(1) A Town Treasurer who shall not simultaneously hold any elective
17	office within Town government. The Town Treasurer shall be:
18	(A) responsible for collection of current taxes; and
19	(B) paid an hourly wage; and
20	(C) open to the public at hours adopted by the Selectboard.

1	(2) A Town Clerk who shall not simultaneously hold any elective office
2	within Town government. The Town Clerk shall be:
3	(A) open to the public at hours adopted by the Selectboard;
4	(B) paid an hourly wage.
5	(b) The Selectboard shall adopt, and revise from time to time, a general
6	statement of the qualifications necessary to perform the duties and
7	responsibilities of each of these appointed Town officers and a job description
8	of those offices. These appointed officers shall exercise all the powers and
9	duties necessary to carry out the provisions of this charter as well as those
10	provided by State law generally.
11	(c) These appointed officers shall be employees of the Town, subject to all
12	personnel and employment rules and policies of the Town and shall serve at
13	the pleasure of the Selectboard. An officer appointed under this section shall
14	be eligible to apply for reappointment at the expiration of his or her term of
15	office, but failure by the Selectboard to make such reappointment shall not be
16	construed as discharge from employment.
17	(d) A person appointed to the position of Town Treasurer or Town Clerk
18	need not be a resident or voter of the Town of Ferrisburgh.
19	§ 4. SEVERABILITY
20	If any provision of this charter is held invalid, the other provisions of this
21	charter shall not be affected thereby.

1	Sec. 3. TRANSITIONAL PROVISION
2	An elected Town Treasurer or Town Clerk in office immediately prior to
3	the effective date of this act may continue to hold that office until July 1, 2018.
4	On that date, the terms of the elected Town Treasurer and Town Clerk shall
5	expire and a Town Treasurer and Town Clerk shall be appointed by
5	the Selectboard as provided in Sec. 2 of this act in the charter of the Town of
7	Ferrisburgh (in 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 119, § 3).
3	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
)	This act shall take effect on passage
