12	§ 8350. CONSENT BY MINORS FOR MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT
13	A minor may give consent to receive any legally authorized outpatient
14	treatment from a mental health professional, as defined in section 7101 of this
15	title. Consent under this section shall not be subject to disaffirmance due to
16	minority of the person consenting. The consent of a parent or legal guardian
17	shall not be necessary to authorize outpatient treatment. As used in this
18	section, "outpatient treatment" means psychotherapy and supportive
19	counseling, but not prescription drugs.
20	Subchapter 2. Prohibition of Conversion Therapy

2	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
3	and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: "An act relating
4	to consent by minors for mental health treatment"
