5	First: By striking out Sec. 4 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the
6	following:
7	Sec. 4. WAIVER OF CERTIFICATE OF NEED REQUIREMENTS
8	Notwithstanding any provisions of 18 V.S.A. chapter 221, subchapter 5 to
9	the contrary:
10	(1) the implementation of renovations at the Brattleboro Retreat as
11	authorized in the fiscal year 2019 capital budget adjustment bill shall not be
12	considered a "new heath care project" for which a certificate of need is
13	required; and
14	(2) the proposal by the University of Vermont Health Network to
15	expand psychiatric inpatient capacity at the Central Vermont Medical Center
16	campus shall be exempt from the requirement to secure a conceptual
17	development phase certificate of need pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 9434(c) if the
18	University of Vermont Health Network:
19	(A) consults with the Secretary of Human Services in identifying the
20	appropriate number and type of additional inpatient beds needed in the State;

1	(B) ensures that the planning process for designing its proposed
2	expansion of inpatient psychiatric bed capacity at the Central Vermont Medical
3	Center campus includes broad stakeholder input, including from patients and
4	providers; and
5	(C) works with the Green Mountain Care Board for ongoing
6	oversight of expenditures.
7	Second: In Sec. 9, amending 2017 Acts and Resolves No. 82, Sec. 3(c), by
8	striking out the third sentence and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
9	The evaluation process shall include such stakeholder involvement in working
10	toward an articulation of a common, long-term vision of full integration of
11	mental health services within a comprehensive and holistic health care system.
