# Home Visiting (\$360,000) and Children's Dental (\$140,000) pilot programs

- Proposed in Gov's Recommend
- NOT FUNDED by House Approps
- Alliance supports funding for existing programs before initiating new programs

#### AHS Grants reduction (\$2m)

- Proposed in Gov's Recommend
- ACCEPTED by House Approps
- Concerns about exactly how "efficiencies" will be gained without harming service delivery and organizational integrity

# DCF Family Services "contact contract" – budget increase (\$500,000)

- Proposed in Gov's Recommend
- FUNDED by House Approps
- Alliance generally supports funding for existing programs before initiating new programs, but understands need/justification for this increased appropriation

### Field Services Directors' Fund reduction (\$43,000)

- Proposed in Gov's Recommend
- ACCEPTED by House Approps
- Alliance opposes this cut, as this Fund can provide critical support to families in crisis that do not qualify for more targeted programs
