**Subject:** Follow Up on Today's Testimony re 911 Compliance Grant Program

Good Afternoon Sen. Flory,

Thank you for the opportunity to discuss the 911 Compliance Grant Program during testimony today. I appreciate all that you and the Committee have done to support this program. I wanted to add two pieces of information that I typically stress during my testimony about the compliance grant, but did not mention today:

- All figures related to the rate of compliance are based on the 304 Vermont public schools.
- We have received test calls from 290 of Vermont public schools – in all but one case (which is in the process of being corrected), the school's name, street address, and community name were accurate. This means that in greater than 99% of tested schools, we can direct responders to the correct building, but may not be able to tell them specifically what room the caller is in within that building.
  - We have been in contact recently with the 14 schools that have not yet placed test calls; arrangements for completing the test calls are underway.
- The Compliance Grant program is currently offered only to Vermont public schools (pre-K – 12) and independent schools that demonstrate they receive public funds for tuition.

Please let me know if this information leads to more questions – I'm happy to discuss anytime.
