(b) Procedure. At the request of the court, the Department of Corrections, or the defendant, the status of a defendant who is detained pretrial in a correctional facility for lack of bail may be reviewed by the court to determine whether the defendant is appropriate for home detention. Such review shall be scheduled upon receipt of a report from DOC approving a residence for home detention by electronic monitoring. At arraignment or after a hearing, The court may order that the defendant be released to the Home Detention Program, providing that the court finds placing the defendant on home detention will reasonably assure his or her appearance in court when required and the proposed residence is appropriate for home detention. "A defendant upon whom monetary bail is imposed under section 7554 of this title (shall) may be offered the opportunity to participate in the Home Detention Program unless the court finds that placing the defendant on home detention will not reasonably assure his or her appearance in court when required or that the proposed residence is inappropriate for home detention"
