7	fees on commercial feed and agricultural fertilizer distributed in the State. The
8	revenue generated from the increased fees would be deposited in the Clean
9	Water Fund for use for the purposes of that Fund.

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 6 V.S.A. § 324 is amended to read:
13	§ 324. REGISTRATION AND FEES
14	(a) No person shall manufacture a commercial feed in this State unless that
15	person has first filed with the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and
16	Markets, in a form and manner to be prescribed by rules <u>rule</u> by the Secretary:
17	(1) the name of the manufacturer;
18	(2) the manufacturer's place of business;
19	(3) the location of each manufacturing facility; and

(4) any other information which that the Secretary considers to be necessary.

- (b) A person shall not distribute in this State a commercial feed that has not been registered pursuant to the provisions of this chapter. Application shall be in a form and manner to be prescribed by rule of the Secretary. The application for registration of a commercial feed shall be accompanied by a registration fee of \$105.00 \$200.00 per product. The Of the registration fees collected under this section, \$95.00 shall be deposited in the Clean Water Fund created by 10 V.S.A. \$ 1388, and \$105.00, along with any surcharges collected under subsection (c) of this section, shall be deposited in the special fund created by subsection 364(e) of this title. Funds deposited in this account the special fund created by subsection 364(e) of this title shall be restricted to implementing and administering the provisions of this title and any other provisions of the law relating to fertilizer, lime, or seeds. If the Secretary so requests, the application for registration shall be accompanied by a label or other printed matter describing the product.
- (c) No person shall distribute in this State any feed required to be registered under this chapter upon which the Secretary has placed a withdrawal from distribution order because of nonregistration. A surcharge of \$10.00, in addition to the registration fee required by subsection (b) of this section, shall accompany the application for registration of each product upon which a

6	(a) A person distributing fertilizer to a nonregistrant consumer in the State
7	annually shall pay the following fees to the Secretary:
8	(1) a \$150.00 minimum tonnage fee;
9	(2) $\$0.50 \ \30.00 per ton of agricultural fertilizer distributed; and
10	(3) \$30.00 per ton of nonagricultural fertilizer distributed.

12	(g)(1) All fees collected under subdivisions (a)(1) and (2) subdivision
13	(a)(1) of this section shall be deposited in the special fund created by
14	subsection 364(e) of this title and used in accordance with its provisions.
15	(2) Of the fees collected under subdivision (a)(2) of this section:
16	(A) \$0.50 per ton shall be deposited in the special fund created by
17	subsection 364(e) of this title and used in accordance with its provisions; and
18	(B) \$29.50 per ton shall be deposited in the Clean Water Fund
