Subject: Fish and wildlife; hunting; fishing; licenses; no-cost license

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to lower from
70 years of age to 65 years of age the age at which a person may receive
certain hunting or fishing licenses at no cost.

An act relating to awarding hunting and fishing licenses at no cost to
persons 65 years of age or older

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 4255(c) is amended to read:

(c) A permanent or free license may be secured on application to the
Department by a person qualifying as follows:

(1) A Vermont resident ~~70~~ 65 years of age or older may receive one or
all of the following licenses at no cost:

(A) a permanent fishing license;
