10	(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of 3 V.S.A. § 2283(c) setting forth
11	the purpose and rate of charges collected in the Human Resource Services
12	Internal Service Fund, in fiscal year 2019, a surcharge of up to 1.65 percent,
13	and in fiscal year 2020 and thereafter, a surcharge of up to 3.3 percent, but no
14	greater than the cost of both the Civil Rights Advisory Panel and the position
15	of Chief Civil Rights Officer set forth in Sec. 3 of this act, on the per-position
16	portion of the charges authorized in 3 V.S.A. § 2283(c)(2) shall be assessed to
17	all Executive Branch agencies, departments, and offices and shall be paid by
18	all assessed entities solely with State funds.
19	(2) The amount collected shall be accounted for within the Human
20	Resource Services Internal Service Fund and used solely for the purposes of

4	Second: By striking out Sec. 5 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof
5	the following:
6	Sec. 5. FISCAL YEAR 2019 APPROPRIATION
7	There is appropriated to the Agency of Administration from the General
8	Fund for fiscal year 2019 the amount of \$75,000.00 for the Civil Rights
9	Advisory Panel and the position of Chief Civil Rights Officer.
