An act relating to workforce development
It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
Sec. 1. 2017 Acts and Resolves No. 69, Sec. E.1(g) is amended to read:
(g) On or before November 15, 2017 December 15, 2018, the Commissioner of Labor and the working group on State workforce development shall report to the Senate Committee on Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs and to the House Committee on Commerce and Economic Development on the implementation of this section and any recommendations for legislative action.

Sec. 2. INTERIM REPORT
The working group on State workforce development created in 2017 Acts and Resolves No. 69, Sec. E.1, shall report to the General Assembly on or before March 15, 2018 on:
(1) recommended actions that can be taken in 2018, which may include endorsing ideas put forward by the administration in its Labor Force Participation Plan;
(2) strategies for the working group, along with the State Workforce Development Board, to implement a three-year initiative to: increase connectivity among workforce development stakeholders; better align collective actions and resources toward increasing the labor force participation rate; redesign the overall workforce development and training system in Vermont; and increase employer-driven workforce solutions; and (3) structural and strategic changes to the State CTE system. Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
