As we discussed during testimony, the Agency of Education and the Office of Professional Regulation will meet during the summer of 2017. During these meetings:

2. We will consult with the Teacher Retirement Office to ensure the impact of such a move on issues in their purview.
3. We will present the results of these conversations to the Senate Education Committee so that you can determine what statutory determinations would be required.
