### EFDA 2018 Financial Information and Important Dates

- Tuition including the Tooth Morphology Course: \$8,900.00. The 6 weeks of summer classroom and lab instruction are offered **June 25-August 3, 2018**. There will be no class on July 4, 2018.
- Application deadline is December 1, 2017. Deposit of \$2,000.00 must accompany application.
- Tooth Morphology Course. This course takes place January 22-24, 2018. Tooth Morphology is a mandatory prerequisite to the 6 weeks of didactic instruction. Enrollment in the Tooth Morphology course is not a guarantee of acceptance into the EFDA Program.
- Notification of acceptance by January 9, 2018.
- Balance of tuition payment will be due as follows:
   \$3,450.00 due on or before March 15, 2018
   \$3,450.00 due on or before April 16, 2018
- There will be no refunds issued after June 4, 2018. (see Form D Refund, Withdrawal, Cancellation and Rescheduling Policies).
- Tuition include textbooks and a typodont..
- Personal loupes are mandatory for the EFDA Program. Bring loupes to the first day of the Tooth Morphology class in January.
- We will accept eight qualified students into the EFDA Program. If we have fewer than eight students enrolled, the program will not run. If we have over eight qualified applicants, those not chosen for the program will be put on a waiting list.
- Students must have a supervising restorative dentist participate with him/her in the program. The dentist will be responsible for supervising the student's cooperative work experience/externship which starts immediately following the six week classroom/lab instruction. The student and dentist have until December 31, 2018 to complete the required clinical competencies. A bench test will be administered on January 12, 2019. After the bench test, students who have successfully completed the program will receive their certificate. Students can invite friends and family members to the brief reception at the conclusion of the bench test (time to be determined at a later date).
- There will be a MANDATORY Satellite Guidelines Meeting for both supervising dentists and EFDA candidates on Saturday, **June 2, 2018** at 10:30 a.m. at the Center for Technology, Essex Dental Clinic. The purpose of the meeting will be for touring the dental facility, meeting the faculty, discussing expectations of the program and receiving textbook and typodont. This meeting is mandatory **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

This SkillTech course is designed to prepare dental assistants for an endorsement in radiology in the dental office.

Emphasis is placed on understanding and practicing the essentials of radiographic clinical procedures.

## HOW TO QUALIFY FOR ADMISSION:

Participant must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or equivalent.

Participant must have been officially registered with the Board of Dental Examiners as a Traditional Dental Assistant for six months and must have completed at least six consecutive months of employment as a dental assistant in a clinical setting prior to taking this course.

## YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND:

## 1. Lecture Session on October 6 (7 hours)

A seven hour lecture session covering theory and techniques used in exposing dental radiographs.

## 2. Preclinical Session (4 hours)

The preclinical session will be scheduled on Tues., Oct. 9 or Thurs., Oct. 11.

## 3. Clinical Session on Oct. 13 (2 hours)

- Expose a complete FMX on a patient. It will be your responsibility to provide a patient. If student doesn't pass the clinical session, there will be a \$fee to retake it.
- Take a written dental radiology exam (must achieve 80% to pass course) and must pass the clinical test out with a grade of 80% or higher. If student doesn't pass the written test, there will be \$65 fee to retake it.
- Student should pick a time on the registration form that is convenient to them.

NOTE: Students will be admitted and scheduled into the Radiology course on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is a limit of 12 students in this course, and on the test out day, there will be a limit of 2 students scheduled for each time.




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
