

## ALUMNI IMPACT

In 2014, **44%** of UVM's **2,319** graduates remained in the state. **64%** of in-state students, and **33%** of out-of-state students stayed.

UVM creates **\$36.7 million** of additional earning power for graduates each year.

## ABOUT THE DATA

These findings are the result of an economic impact study conducted by Tripp Umbach, a Pittsburgh-based research firm also working with University of Vermont Medical Center. The study draws on fiscal year 2014 data and reports on three types of economic impact: direct (investments in construction and operations); indirect (purchases from area suppliers) and induced (household spending from earnings of direct and indirect expenditures). UVM's cost for this research: \$25,000 (privately funded).
