2	The Committee on Finance to which was referred House Bill No. 904
3	entitled "An act relating to miscellaneous agricultural subjects" recommends
4	that the Senate propose to the House that the bill as amended by the Committee
5	on Natural Resource and Energy be further amended as follows:
6	First: By adding Secs. 21a–21c to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21a. TRANSFER FROM CEDF TO GENERAL FUND; TAX
8	EXPENDITURE; ADVANCED WOOD BOILERS
9	(a) Beginning July 1, 2018, the Clean Energy Development Fund quarterly
10	shall calculate the foregone sales tax on advanced wood fired boilers resulting
11	from the sales tax exemption under 32 V.S.A. § 9741(52) for advanced wood
12	boilers. Beginning October 1, 2018, the Clean Energy Development Fund
13	shall notify the Department of Taxes of the amount of sales tax foregone in the
14	preceding calendar quarter resulting from the sales tax exemption under 32
15	V.S.A. § 9741(52) for advanced wood boilers.
16	(b) In fiscal years 2019 and 2020, the Clean Energy Development Fund
17	shall transfer from the Clean Energy Development Fund to the General Fund
18	the amount of the tax expenditure resulting from the sales tax exemption under
19	32 V.S.A. § 9741(52) on advanced wood boilers up to a maximum of
20	\$200,000.00 for both fiscal years combined. The Department shall deposit 64
21	percent of the monies transferred from the Clean Energy Development Fund

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1	into the General Fund under 32 V.S.A. § 435 and 36 percent of the monies in
2	the Education Fund under 16 V.S.A. § 4025.

4	OF THE CLEAN ENERGY DEVELOPMENT FUND
5	On or before January 15, 2019, the Department of Public Service, after
6	consultation with the Agency of Commerce and Community Development, the
7	Department of Forests, Parks, and Recreation, and renewable energy
8	organizations, shall submit to the Senate Committees on Finance, on
9	Appropriations, and on Natural Resources and Energy and the House
10	Committees on Ways and Means, on Appropriations, and on Energy and
11	Technology a recommended source of funding sufficient to sustainably fund
12	the authorized uses of the Clean Energy Development Fund as provided under
13	<u>30 V.S.A. § 8015.</u>
14	Sec. 21c. REPEAL
15	(a) 32 V.S.A. § 9741(52) (sales tax exemption for advanced wood boilers)
16	shall be repealed on July 1, 2021.
17	(b) Sec. 21a of this act (transfer from CEDF) shall be repealed on July 1,
18	<u>2021.</u>
