

1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2 The Committee on Finance to which was referred House Bill No. 904  
3 entitled “An act relating to miscellaneous agricultural subjects” recommends  
4 that the Senate propose to the House that the bill as amended by the Committee  
5 on Natural Resource and Energy be further amended by striking out Secs. 19–  
6 21 (sales tax exemption for advanced wood boilers) and their reader assistance  
7 and inserting in lieu thereof the following new Secs. 19–21:

8 \* \* \* Advanced Wood Boilers; CEDF\* \* \*

9 Sec. 19. FLAT-RATE INCENTIVE; ADVANCED WOOD BOILER

10 During fiscal year (FY) 2019, the Department of Public Service (the  
11 Department) shall continue to administer the Clean Energy Development  
12 Fund’s wood heating incentive program (the program) that pays a flat rate  
13 incentive for the installation of an approved wood pellet boiler or wood  
14 furnace. During FY 2019, the Department shall pay a flat-rate incentive of  
15 \$4,000.00 from the Clean Energy Development Fund for the installation of an  
16 approved pellet boiler or furnace and shall otherwise apply the same eligibility  
17 requirements for the program that were in effect during FY 2018.

18 Sec. 20. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE REPORT ON FUNDING  
19 OF THE CLEAN ENERGY DEVELOPMENT FUND

20 On or before January 15, 2019, the Department of Public Service, after  
21 consultation with the Agency of Commerce and Community Development, the

1 Department of Forests, Parks, and Recreation, and renewable energy  
2 organizations, shall submit to the Senate Committees on Finance, on  
3 Appropriations, and on Natural Resources and Energy and the House  
4 Committees on Ways and Means, on Appropriations, and on Energy and  
5 Technology a recommended source of funding sufficient to sustainably fund  
6 the authorized uses of the Clean Energy Development Fund as provided under  
7 30 V.S.A. § 8015.
