

1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2 The Committee on Health and Welfare to which was referred Senate Bill  
3 No. 253 entitled “An act relating to Vermont’s adoption of the Interstate  
4 Medical Licensure Compact” respectfully reports that it has considered the  
5 same and recommends that the bill be amended by striking out Sec. 2, effective  
6 date, in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 Sec. 2. 3 V.S.A. § 123(j)(1) is amended to read:

8 (j)(1) The Office may inquire into the criminal background histories of  
9 applicants for licensure and for biennial license renewal for the following  
10 professions:

11 (A) licensed nursing assistants, licensed practical nurses, registered  
12 nurses, and advanced practice registered nurses licensed under 26 V.S.A.  
13 chapter ~~59~~ 28;

14 (B) private investigators, security guards, and other persons licensed  
15 under 26 V.S.A. chapter 59; ~~and~~

16 (C) real estate appraisers and other persons or business entities  
17 licensed under 26 V.S.A. chapter 69; and

18 (D) osteopathic physicians licensed under 26 V.S.A. chapter 33.

19 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

20 This act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
