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The project would include the renovation of former Rockingham Public Safety Barracks to relocate the Agency of Natural Resources Regional Offices from the Springfield State Office Building (SSOB). The Natural Resources Board will remain at SSOB.

The scope includes renovating the building to open office space to accommodate 38 employees, including a locker room addition, and secure fencing. The site provides the consolidation of storage operations from the leased land at the Springfield Airport. This would include rebuilding the 4000 sqft pole barn from the airport site. The project is currently early in the programming process.

The vacant space at the SSOB would allow the Department of Labor and Agency of Human Services Office of Public Guardian, to move from leased space to the State Office Building.
