5 (14) “Dispatchable Location” means the location information delivered  
6 to the public safety answering point with a 911 call.

7 (15) “Enterprise Communications Systems (ECS)” means any  
8 networked communication system serving two or more stations, or living units,  
9 within an enterprise. ECS includes circuit-switched networks, such as multi-  
10 line telephone systems or legacy ECS, IP-enabled service, and cloud-based  
11 technology.

12 (16) “Station” means a telephone handset, customer premise equipment  
13 (CPE) or calling device that is capable of initiating a call to 911.

15 § 7057. ~~PRIVATELY OWNED TELEPHONE SYSTEMS~~ ENTERPRISE  
16 COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS

17 Any ~~privately owned telephone system~~ enterprise communications system  
18 shall provide to those end users the same level of 911 service that other end  
19 users receive and shall provide ANI signaling, station identification data,  
20 including dispatchable location, and updates to Enhanced 911 databases under  
21 rules adopted by the Board. The Board may waive the provisions of this  
22 section for any ~~privately owned telephone system~~ enterprise communications  
23 system, provided that in the judgment of the Board, the owner of the system is

1 actively engaged in becoming compliant with this section, is likely to comply  
2 with this section in a reasonable amount of time, and will do so in accordance  
3 with standards and procedures adopted by the Board by rule.
